*Kitchen Cabinet Refacing means replacing the doors, drawer fronts and hardware, and covering the existing cabinet boxes with stick on veneer and plywood. Others options like replacing the drawer boxes and some add on cabinets are also common.

*What you get is a **beautiful new look kitchen at about 1/3 the cost** of new cabinets. You also avoid the mess, inconvenience and extra time of completely removing and replacing your cabinets.
